
ORO BELLO 2019 ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

- Fermentation @ 62F for over 14 days

Additions!

Unlike most rosés (that are notorious for using a lot of chemicals to top drop bitterness and color like PVPP or carbon, as well as other fining agents), our wine contains only grapes and yeast and the absolute minimum amount of sulfites necessary.

VINEYARD SOURCES

100% Pinot Noir **Foster Vineyard** Russian River AVA, California

Foster Vineyard was planted in the early 2000's and located in the Russian River Valley. The Russian River Valley appellation lies at the geographical heart of Sonoma County and is best known for its Pinot Noir. The soil type at Foster Vineyard is Huichica loam. The fog rolls in from the Pacific Ocean and layers the valley, causing diurnal temperature swings of 35 degrees. The warm days and cool nights extend the maturity and allow the fruit to reach their optimal flavor development.
