A blend of fruits, florals and spices fills the nose and palate, reminiscent of blackberry jam, black cherry, dried violets, chocolate, cinnamon, nutmeg, toasted wood and black tea. Plush tannins coat the mouth while balanced acidity adds lift and lightness to the midpalate. It's an overall engaging, full-bodied red wine.

Rorick Heritage Vineyard is situated on limestone soils beneath a top layer of schist. The alpine growing season combined.with limestone soils leave an indelible mark on the wines grown there with beautiful aromatics, textural presence, and bright natural acidity are all hallmarks of the site.
